Aims and Objectives of the Cell:

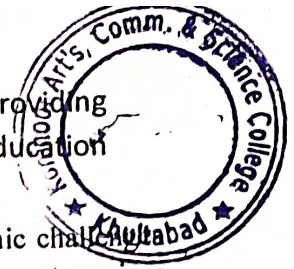

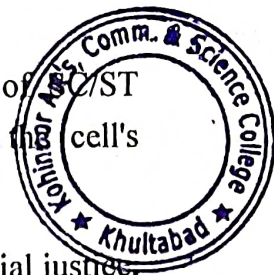

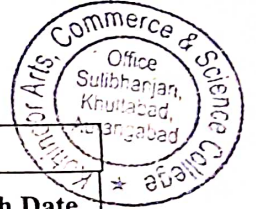
Conclusion:
