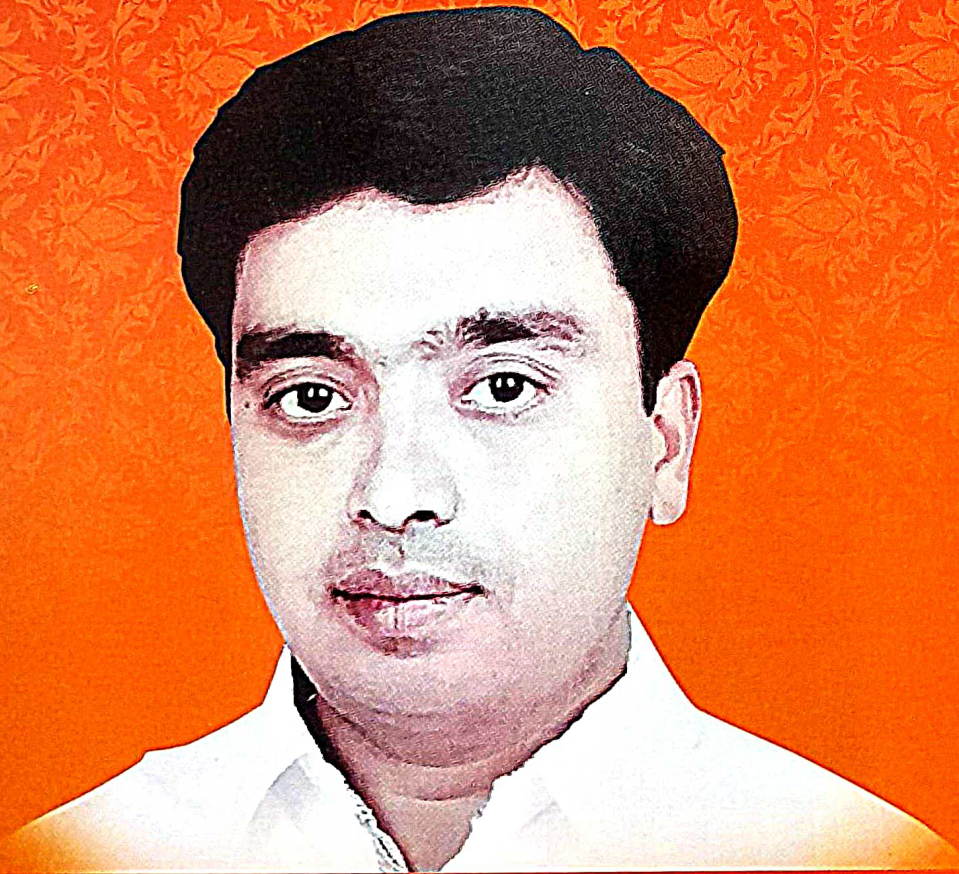

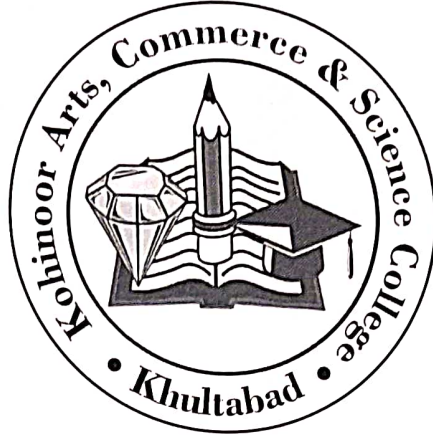

The Kohinoor Shikshan Sanstha, Aurangabad was established by Late. Idris Khan Saheb in the year 1992. He was born in 1954. He was the Aurangabad district President of Congress committee for some period. He has two daughters namely Asma Khan and Zeba Khan. Kohinoor Arts College was started at Khultabad under the Kohinoor Shikshan Sanstha, Aurangabad in the year June 2000. He passed away on 26th August 2005. Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb transformed this small plant into a big banyan tree. The real progress of the college began when Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb became Secretary of Kohinoor Shikshan Sanstha, Aurangabad in the year 2005 later on he became President of the society. Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb was born on 26th March 1982 in a small village Mahal Kinholi, Tehsil Phulambri District Aurangabad. Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb's father Late Anwar Khan Saheb was the Sarpanch of Mahal Kinholi. Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb's paternal uncle's names are Late Haji Hyder Khan and Haji Sarwar Khan. He has two brothers namely Mohsin Khan and Haji Maksud Khan.

He has got co-operation of his mother Daulatbi, wife Smt. Asma Khan and younger brother Shri. Haji Maksud Khan during his successful career. Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb has been working in the fields like social, political and educational for the welfare of the people. Anybody who seeks help from him seldom returns empty handed. He got blessings of his ancestors, teachers and Ulama.

Soon after becoming the President of the society Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb at first started Commerce and Science faculties in the year June 2008 and (11th and 12th) Junior college in the year 2010 to provide the opportunity of higher education under one roof to the children of people residing in hilly, rural areas of Khultabad tehsil and also to the students belonging to all the sections of the society including minorities, farmers, small vendors, financially weak and farm labourers. After completion of graduation in Arts, Commerce and Science faculties in Khultabad students had to go Aurangabad and other places to pursue post graduation courses and it was not affordable for poor parents to send their children including girls there leading to close the doors of higher education for them. So to provide quality education in post graduation courses to such students Hon'ble Dr. Mazhar Khan Saheb started M.A. in 8 subjects, M.Sc in 5 subjects and M.Com in the year June 2013. After that students from Aurangabad and from all over the state have been coming to Kohinoor campus.

The post graduation courses further expanded with another 4 subjects in the year 2018. B.Voc courses were started in the campus since 2014 to provide skills based

education instead of traditional education to the students and also to help them to start their own business. Professional courses like D.Pharm in 2018 , B. Pharm in 2021 , B.B.A. and B.C.A. were started. M.K. Homeopathic Medical College and Hospital is going to be started in the year 2023.

The campus of Kohinoor Shikshan Sanstha, Aurangabad is spread in 12 acres . The progress of the society in the field of education is rapidly growing. Around 6 to 7 thousand students have been taking education in the various courses running under the society. Students from Khultabad tehsil, other districts and from all over the state have been coming here to take education in the college. Now a day's Kohinoor College has been regarded as a esteemed college in the field of education and the credit goes to Hon'ble Dr Mazhar Khan Saheb , all the senior professors and non teaching staff members.

With a focus on raising employability of graduates and meeting the industry's requirement for ready-to-work students, this course seeks to provide skill and specialization in different vocations. It will have a multiple-exit provision - a diploma at the end of the first year and an advanced diploma after two years. It organizes qualifications based on levels of knowledge, skill and aptitude. This would enable the graduates completing B. Voc. to make a meaningful participation.

Bachelor of Business Administration (B.B.A.)

The Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) is a three-year (full time) professional undergraduate course in Business Management. It is open to students from all the three streams: Science, Arts and Commerce. The BBA course offers knowledge and training in management and leadership skills to prepare them for managerial roles and entrepreneurship. The course will help the students learn various aspects of business administration and management through classroom lectures and practical projects like internships. The course will acquaint the students with various aspects of the business administration, market, marketing trends, etc.

Eligibility :

A candidate who has passed his H.S.C examination from any stream from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Pune, or any other examination equivalent thereto, OR A student who has passed the Minimum Competency Based Vocational Course (MCVC) at 10+2 level shall be eligible for admission to his course.

Program Duration:

B.B.A. Programme will be a full time Six Semesters (Three Years) duration.

Bachelor of Computer Application (B.C.A.)

The full form of BCA is Bachelors in Computer Application. BCA is a three year (full time) undergraduate degree Programme for candidates wishing to delve into the world of Computer languages. One of the most popular options to get started with a career in Information Technology, the course gives you an insight into the world of computers and its applications. A BCA degree is considered to be at par with a BTech/BE degree in Computer Science or Information Technology. The degree helps interested students in setting up a sound academic base for an advanced career in Computer Applications.

A candidate, who has passed his H.S.C examination from any stream from Maharashtra State Board of Secondary & Higher Secondary Education, Pune, or any other examination equivalent thereto, OR A candidate who has passed Diploma of Engineering from the Board of Technical Education Govt. of Maharashtra or any other examination equivalent there to shall be eligible for admission to his course.

1. A Candidate desirous to seek admission for the Post Graduation Course shall be admitted provided that he / she has passed the Bachelors Degree Examination from a Recognized University as one of the subjects seeking admission for Post Graduation Course.
2. CET, Common entrance test for admission to Post Graduation Course will be conducted by the college as per University Norms. Question Paper Pattern will be based in graduation Syllabus. Date for CET will be announced shortly.

Admission Rules

The prospectus along with an application form for admission to the desired course at Kohinoor Arts, Commerce & Science College will be made available from the date of declaration S.S.C./ H.S.C. / Graduation results of the Maharashtra Board / Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University or any recognized Board / University through out India.

For admission to any class it is necessary to produce the original and a photocopy of each of the following documents as demanded by college authorities,

No Objection Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended with the Enrolment / Eligibility Confirmation Number. (for students from other colleges who wish to join the S.Y. and T.Y. classes) and also for Post Graduation Courses

Eligibility Certificate (for students passing an examination from Boards other than the Maharashtra Board). Students passing the Std. X / XII examination conducted by Board / University other than Maharashtra should submit a copy of the mark sheet and apply in the prescribed form for Eligibility Certificate with the necessary documents and fees at the time of admission (i.e. name on the merit list in case of first year student).

After accepting the Eligibility Form, the college will apply to the concern authority Board / University of Dr. BAMU for the provisional Statement of Eligibility Certificate. The Eligibility Certificate will be issued in a few days. If the student is found not Eligible for the course, 50% amount of the fees will be deducted and 50% will be refunded to the student as per admission rule.

Students should pay the necessary charges for getting the mark sheets verified by the Board from which they pass their H.S.C. examination and submit the following. For confirmation of the eligibility, students should submit their details with following documents to the College Office before the close of the first term.

FEES

1. Students should pay the prescribed fees to the Accounts Section or Special Counters opened for the purpose at the time of admission.
2. Schedule of fees will be displayed on the College Notice Board from time to time.
3. Fees will be accepted in Cash / Cheque at the authorized counter only of college.
4. Parents / Guardians should ensure that they obtain a receipt immediately after any payment of fees is made to the college.
5. Care should be taken to ensure that payments are not made to unauthorized persons. The College will not be responsible for any lapse in this matter.
6. Reserve Category Students must fill the Freeship / Scholarship forms as per the schedule displayed on the Notice Board.
7. Eligible Reserve Category students will be exempted from paying full regular fees. The proposal will be sent to the Social Welfare Department, Government of Maharashtra for its sanction. They will be required to pay the Fees not sanctioned by the Social Welfare Department in the Second Term.

REFUND OF FEES :

On cancellation of Admission, refund of fees will be as per the guidelines of Board/University. The refund amount will be paid by cheque within 30 working days from the date of cancellation of Admission.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

1) Regular Activities:

2) Special Winter Camps :

During the special winter camp programme of 10 days, every year common activities such as shramdan, Tree Plantation, repairs and construction of roads, Cleaning of the area, Slide shows, talks/ lectures, Village Survey, Cultural activities, Blood Donation, Trekking, Nature watch, Rallies, etc. are undertaken along with some special activities.

LABORATORIES

The college has well equipped laboratories for Physics, Biology, Chemistry, Geology, Psychology, Home Science, Geography, Microbiology Electronics and Environmental Science for our Junior College / Degree College & Post Graduation Courses. We also have fully air conditioned Computer Laboratory for students who require the facility for their course content.

Sciences Tour

We offer a special student-led tour that focuses on our science facilities. The tours usually include the classrooms and laboratories of a wide variety of departments such as astronomy and astrophysics, chemistry, ecology and evolutionary biology, molecular biophysics and biochemistry, molecular, cellular, and developmental biology, geology and geophysics and physics. Student will learn about cutting-edge research, special science programs.

COLLEGE CANTEEN

The College Canteen is a large spacious area and maintained in hygienic condition surround by greenery all around, and a variety of refreshments and meals are served. It tends to be the most popular place on campus, not only for refreshment but also for student bonding, discussions and even work on assignments and projects.

execution of curricular and extra-curricular activities and redressal of grievances, if any. The Student's Council organizes various intra-collegiate events such as Friendship Day, Rose Day, Traditional Day, Art to Art exhibition, painting, mehendi and rangoli competitions, musical programmes, Annual Scholar's and Gymkhana Days, Annual variety entertainment programme with the assistance of celebrity alumni. It also organizes the annual inter-collegiate festival "Kshitij" in which inter-collegiate competitions in Marathi one-act play, solo singing, folk dance, cricket, football are conducted. The Marathi one act plays that have secured the top three positions in the prestigious Purshottamkarandak competitions are invited to participate in the competition. The College is a pioneer in the organizing Marathi one act play & student of our college participate in various competitions every year.

CAREER COUNSELING CENTRE

In the month of August and September, sessions were conducted on every Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday at Career Counseling Center.

Orientation session:

Orientation sessions are held for all the classes to brief the students about the services provided by the counseling center.

Individual sessions:

Career counseling sessions are held for various students from all streams in Junior to Post Graduation Students. Various queries from students were answered about courses, their eligibility, entrance exams and institutes. Information was also given about general options after H.S.C. and after Graduation to many students. Personal counseling sessions were also held for a few students.

LIBRARY

The library is the nerve centre of all the academic activities in the college. It provides a place for study and services to assist study. It also facilities exist solely to cater to the needs of the academic community of the college.

Kohinoor's Library offers membership to Professors and students who have enrolled in the current academic year. Ex-students / others can avail the reference facility by permission from the Principal/Librarian.

The College Library has a separate building with spacious Stock Room, Reading halls for Staff, Boys and Girls. The Library has a huge collection of books & journals on a variety of subjects. Students can avail of the Internet facility on payment of nominal charges.

Library Rules:

1. While entering the library, students should carry their Identity & Library cards.
2. Students will ensure that they do not disturb the decorum of the library.
3. Books are issued for home reading for a period of one week only against a demand slip (duly filled and signed) on days notified for this purpose. Reference Books and prescribed text books kept in the reading hall, Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, Atlas and other books classified as reference books must be used in the library only during working hours.
4. A student failing to return books issued to him/her for home reading on or before the due date will be liable to pay a fine of Rs. 5/- per day till such time as the book is returned.
5. Students will not be issued more than one book at a time for home reading.
6. Books issued against the Identity Card are for use in the Reading Hall only and must be returned while leaving the library. Disciplinary action will be taken against students violating this rule.
7. Use of Mobiles is strictly prohibited in the Library.
8. We have separate common rooms for boys and girls where they can relax, catch up with notes and friends, where they can discuss & chat on their interested topics.

SPORTS

Kohinoor provides facilities for Indoor Sports like Chess, Carom and Table Tennis. We also offer facilities for Outdoor Sports including Basketball, Volleyball Athletics, Hockey & Football on Kohinoor college ground.

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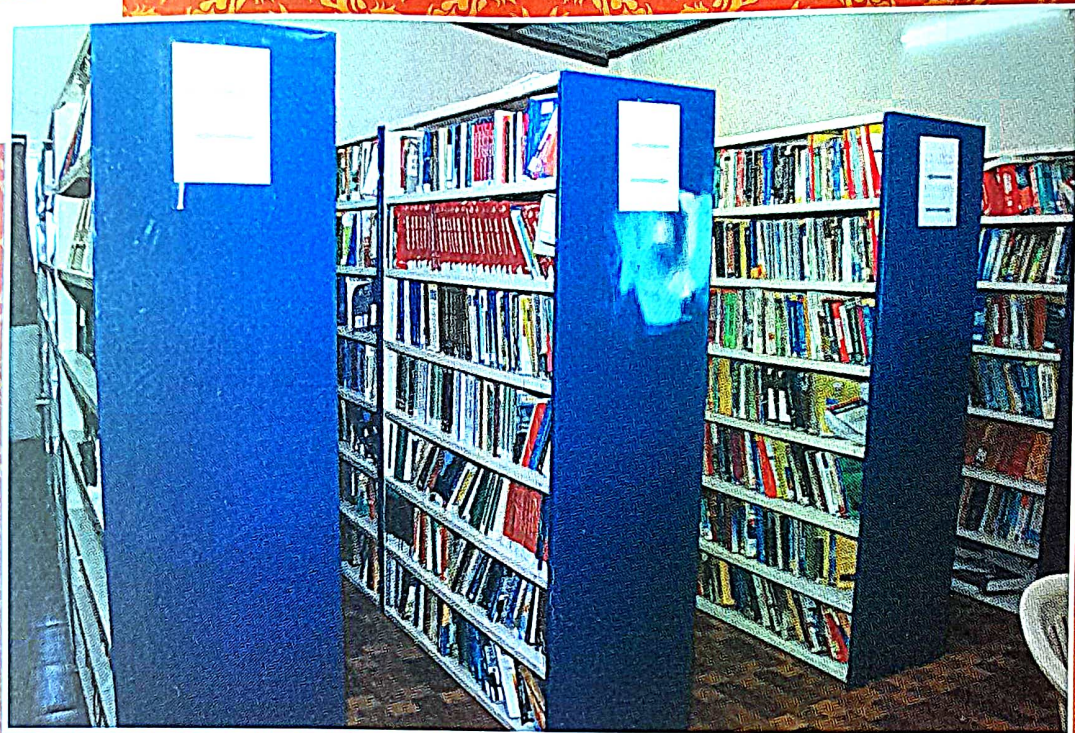
